2019 Lottery Report

In 2019, we held several raffles and lotteries, realizing a profit of \$11,492.36 combined, being up from last year. 50/50 raffles were held at our monthly meetings, 50/50 raffles and other raffles were held at our fundraising events, making a profit of \$2,229.00, also up from last year.

Nevada ticket sales were up significantly this past year, realizing a profit of \$7,787.08. We very much appreciate the Avondale Store on George Street for selling the Nevada tickets and allowing us to be the beneficiary of the sales.

The Super Draw 100 Lottery was successful, not only financially, but it does create some excitement at our monthly meetings, and a fun social night at the Elimination Draw. The evening consists of a buffet dinner, entertainment, and silent auction, all included in the purchase price of the ticket. This past year, we made a profit of \$1,476.28 on the draw and \$735.50 from the silent auction after expenses.

The revenue received through the lotteries has enabled us to purchase several items and pay for expenses incurred in the running of the museum. The Lottery Account continues to pay rent to the General Account for the Museum to help offset some of the costs. A detailed Financial Statement giving full details of income and expenditures is shown to the right.

The support and cooperation received from our members and the community is appreciated.
